

1 Inserting an Html Signature


An Html Signature can be inserted into the users' profile. This Html Signature will appear automatically when the users send an email, send quotes or automatic emails sent from certain areas of the system.

1.1 Follow these steps to insert a Html Signature

1. Click on the **User Profile** option from the avatar bubble at the top of the screen or click on the **Edit** link to the left of the user's name.



2. Click on the **HTML Signature** button.



3. Add in the email signature by either pasting it from a different platform or typing it in and using the buttons in the toolbar to add in links and images.





4. Search and select the picture from your computer and click on the **Open** button.




5. Once back on the previous screen, click on the **Ok** button to save the image on the signature.
